1. Policy Statement

1.1 www.matthewalgie.com is a site operated by Matthew Algie & Company Limited. We are registered in Scotland under company number SC028433. Our registered office is at Matthew Algie & Company Ltd, 16 Lawmoor Road, Glasgow, G5 0UL, UK.

2. General Information

- 2.1. Our site uses cookies to distinguish you from other users. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our site and also allows us to improve our site. A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed onto your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps examine web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site.
- 2.2. Essentially, cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.
- 2.3. Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie does NOT give us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.
- 2.4. We use cookies on our website and we assume you are ok with this, otherwise please disable cookies in your browser or navigate away and clear cookies set by the website. By continuing to browse the site, you are consenting to our use of cookies.
- 2.5. We reserve the right to modify or amend the use of cookies at any time and for any reason. Any changes will be posted on our site and will take effect as soon as they are posted. By continuing to use our site after any changes are posted you are indicating your acceptance of those changes.

3. Cookies we use

- 3.1 We use the following cookies:
 - a) **Strictly necessary cookies**: These are cookies that are required for the operation of our site. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our site. The following is strictly necessary in the operation of our website.

Remember what is in your shopping basket

Remember where you are in the order process

Remember that you are logged in and that your session is secure. You need to be logged in to complete an order.

- b) Analytical/performance cookies: These cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors to our site and to see how visitors move around our site when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our site works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- c) **Functionality cookies:** These are used to recognise you when you return to our site. This enables us to personalise our content for you and remember your preferences.
- d) Targeting cookies: These cookies record your visit to our site, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. This information will be used by us and third parties to make our site and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.
- e) **Website Cookies**: So you can easily "Like" or share our content on certain social media sites such Facebook and Twitter we have included sharing buttons on our site. These cookies are set by the third party social media sites to which they relate. The privacy implications vary from social media site to social media site and will be dependent on the privacy settings you have chosen on these sites, please refer to the social media site's privacy and cookies policy for more information. Please note that third parties may also use cookies, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies. Our site, like most websites, includes functionality provided by third parties. A common example is an

embedded video powered by YouTube and Vimeo. Disabling these cookies may mean you cannot access the functions offered by these third parties. Our third party marketing partners (e.g. Google and Facebook) will use cookies to better target our paid channels.
